<u>Scenario</u>

The concepts of loneliness and isolation in their different aspects have been intensively discussed within the European Week of Active and Healthy Ageing 2021. In the European context, facing and contrasting the phenomenon of loneliness and isolation, meaning by this term every phenomenon of social and civil exclusion, disconnection and marginalization for origins or causes connected to the personal, socio-health, economic or cultural condition is relevant and alarming in such senses. In fact, the UE Regions actively promote and encourage the Civil Society Organisations and SMEs to draft projects and enhance experiences aimed at understanding and preventing the emergence of such phenomenon.

Nowadays, technologies and innovation strategies are very fast on their on-going progress of accelerator and implementation of ideas and solutions, that sometime some people may do not be included in this virtuous and fast process. For this reason, Trieste Citizen Accelerator wants to create the perfect context to addressing major issues of an ageing and changing society through the support of digital innovation/tech solutions. Programme Explanation

The **Trieste Citizen Accelerator** will be structured in different sessions (two-days full), with these compositive characteristics:

Day 1 OPENING

- Institutional Greetings
- Topics announcement & Introduction
- Pre-screening of ideas/prototypes

Day 1-2 TRAINING/CONTAMINATION/COOPERATIVE PROCESS

AAL

A collective and in the same time selective training preliminary session for sharing/discussing knowledges, topics of interest, ideas, partial solutions furnished by experts and identified mentors of each team.

Topics:

- General topics in the field of isolation and loneliness
- Successful solution plan (vision, missions and business models)
- Organizational inputs (functionalities, processes, equipment, investment-business and risk assessment and plans and management)
- Innovation strategies and methods presentation (idea-value)
- Methodologies for prototyping

Day 1 SELECTION PROCESS: all projects/solutions must be oriented into the main objectives of the competition, those that are able to generate investments/interest's attractiveness are the potential winners for the awards. All solutions have to explain particularly their sustainability impact in the sectoral field.

SELECTION CRITERIA on these bases:

- Ideation of business models & innovative ideas to contrast the issues;
- creation and implementation of Innovative, High-tech and IT Products, services, solutions in specific sectors;
- realization of Advanced, Digital and Innovative Engineering solutions for specific sectors;
- boasting and reenabling of products/service on the market;
- improvement and acceleration of processes through innovative strategies in the sectoral fields;

Day 1-2 PRE-PITCH AND PITCH PRESENTATION TO THE JURY

The pitch (presentation of team ideas and solutions) & prototype performance & business idea presentation must last only 5 minutes, afterwards a Q&A session will take place from the jury and also citizens on the second date.

The Jury will be composed by experts & institutional representatives and will award the best tech & social ideas/solutions at the end of the evaluation process.
